 I have removed quickstart applications LinkedIn (git\quickstarts\camel\camel-linkedin) and ErrorHandler (git\quickstarts\beginner\camel-errorhandler) using the Eclipse GUI and according to that I have succeeded with the uninstall:



These quickstarts have been loaded directly from the quickstarts GIT repository on about July 27.

2) However I have failed to uninstall these two, which I can see in numerous ways:
