

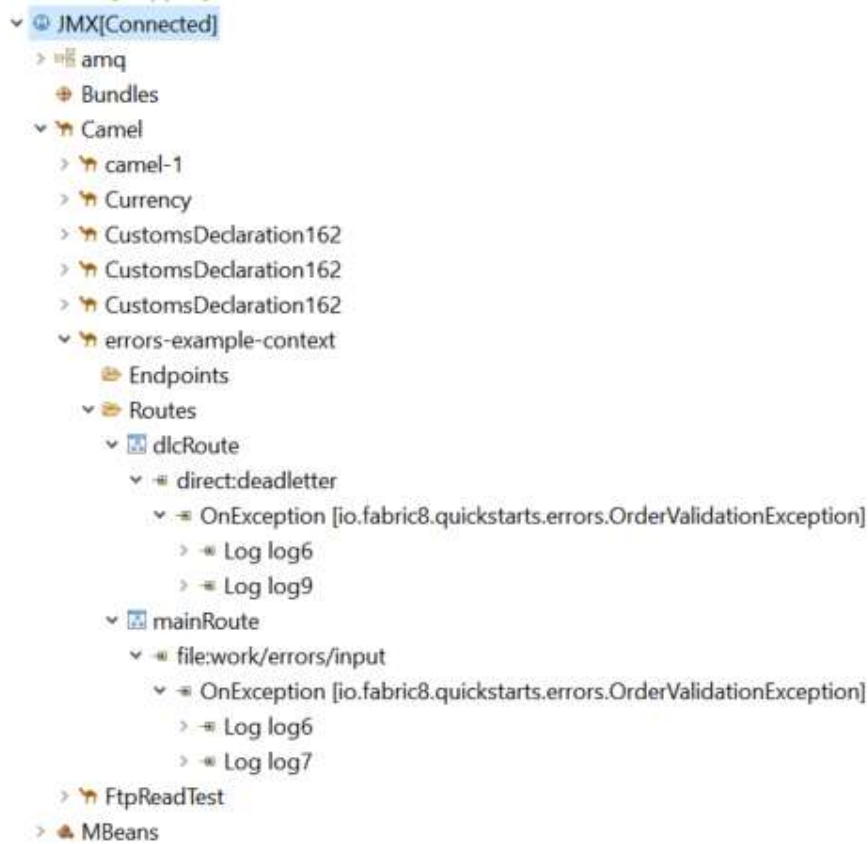
Here is an example of the bug using quickstarts:

- 1) I have removed quickstart applications LinkedIn (git\quickstarts\camel\camel-linkedin) and ErrorHandler (git\quickstarts\beginner\camel-errorhandler) using the Eclipse GUI and according to that I have succeeded with the uninstall:



These quickstarts have been loaded directly from the quickstarts GIT repository on about July 27.

- 2) However I have failed to uninstall these two, which I can see in numerous ways:

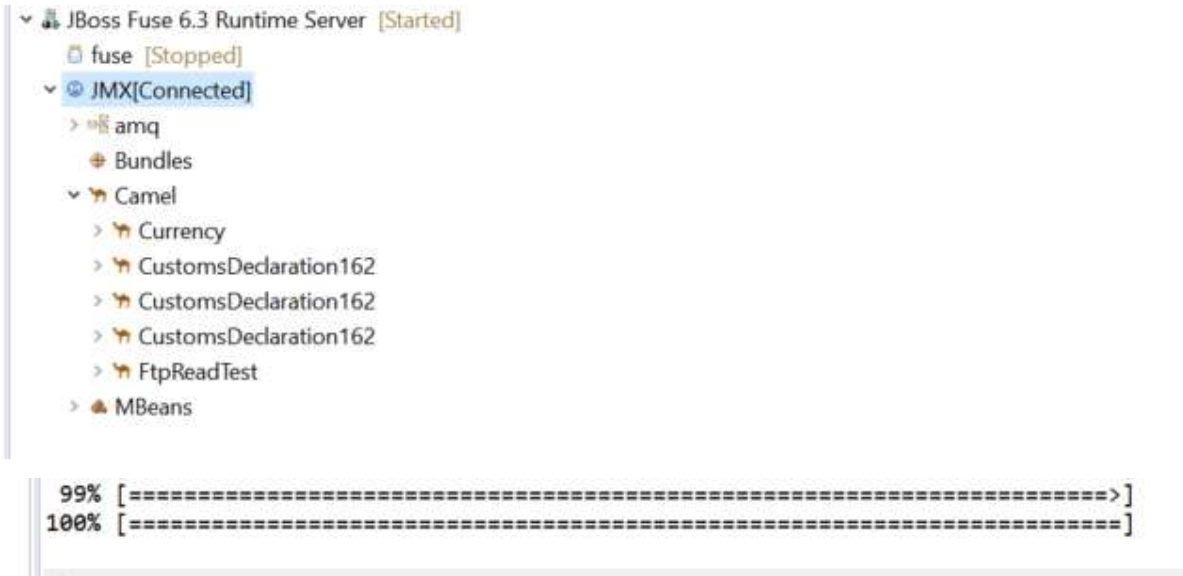

- 3) osgi:uninstall works

In this case running command `osgi:uninstall 409 410 405` works (I seem to have installed errorhandler twice in two different ways, but this issue is about when I install these with maven/devstudio).
